Rules and Membership Terms

HBC - Refers to Hickory Bluff Club (HBC).

Member - Member with rights to use the Marina facilities, members pricing on Bait, Ice, Gas and attend marina functions.

Associate Member - Member with rights to use the Marina facilities, members pricing on Bait, Ice, Gas, and attend marina functions. Associate Members are not entitled to launch, recover boats and overnight dock at the marina.

Commercial Member - Person or businesses that use the marina to conduct business. Such type businesses are to include but not limited to Boat Dealers/Brokers/Manufacturers, Commercial Fisherman, Charter Operators and Corporations for entertainment or functions etc. Commercial memberships maybe limited by type of business according to capacity of the marina decided by the management. Commercial Members will conduct their business without interference to the normal operation or other members of the marina and provide proof of adequate insurance.

Immediate Family Members - Spouse, children, or significant other living within the same household. Immediate Family Members are considered a Member. Children 18 to 25 years old must be in school or college to be considered a Member.

Guest - Person whom is invited by a Member to use marina facilities. Guest must be accompanied by a Member at all times while on Marina premises.

Conduct - Members will respect the rights of all members. This is a club based on a strong fellowship and any inconsiderate acts to fellow members will not be tolerated on marina premises.

Dockage - A Member will be allowed to dock his vessel at the Marina dock free of charge. The dock has limited space so be considerate of others when docking your boat. Owners are responsible for insuring that their vessels are securely moored to avoid damage to adjacent vessels or the pontoons.

Boat Launch and Recovery - Any Member may launch and recover his vessel an unlimited number of times free of charge. A lift operator will be provided during normal business hours and will launch and recover all vessels. If a Member launches or recovers their own vessel outside of normal business hours, HBC will assume no liability for damages to vessel or injury to personnel. Members will be responsible for all damages that occur to the hoist system or docks while a Member is launching their own vessel. Associate Members nor Guest will not launch or recover any vessel at any time.

Insurance Coverage - All Vessels will carry adequate Liability Insurance. Hickory Bluff Club is not liable for any damages occurring on Marina property. HBC shall not be liable for

the protection of or damage to boats, their content, gear or equipment. The Member acknowledges and understands that HBC will only provide casual security for the facility. HBC shall not be liable for personal injuries to the member, his family or guest, resulting from the use of any part of the facility. HBC makes no warranty of any kind as to the condition of the piers, ramps, floats, moorings or any other facility or service. Members of all types are responsible for any damage caused by him, his guest or family members to the dock, structures, pilings or any other equipment. Each member is responsible for injury or damage to any other person or property resulting from their use of the HBC facility or area, including damage to other boats.

Litter - Members are requested to ensure that all litter is placed in designated trash bins.

Fishing and Swimming - Only Members, guest, are allowed to fish on Marina docks. There will not be any swimming or diving around any dock at anytime.

Motorized Vehicles - Golf Carts, ATVs, UTVs, are not permitted beyond the entrance to the boat launch.

Security and Vandalism - HBC reserves the right, but not the duty, to take action to minimize vandalism, theft and other criminal acts of parties and may take action to minimize intrusion upon the Marina by unauthorized persons. Under no circumstances will HBC be responsible for the security of Members vessels or other personal property located on the Marina premises. HBC and its employees retain the right to summon law enforcement officers to enforce trespass and other criminal laws of every kind and nature.

Compliance - Member and his boat(s) must comply with all Federal, State and County regulations.

Breach of Rules - HBC Management reserves the right to terminate any Membership as it deems necessary and the Member dues will be forfeited. HBC may terminate this agreement by providing written notice of termination to Member.

Marina Tabs - For the convenience of Members. Tabs need to be paid in full every week or after each use period, i.e. if you fish for 3 days in a row when you take out settle up your tab.

Rule Changes - HBC may amend or change these rule at any time and will post any change at the marina or website forum.

Website Forum - Is for use by members to share information, pictures and gather online. Feel free to use it for any ideas that you have. Profanity or any obscene use of the forum will result in termination of your forum rights.
